WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require both the assigned oversight committee and the Finance Committee to approve all requests to apply for grants from Federal and State agencies, as well as grants from all other entities; and,

WHEREAS, County policies and procedures require that the acceptance of grants of \$30,000 or more must be approved by the full County Board;

WHEREAS, the Department of Child Advocacy Center wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the Child Advocacy Center program in the amount of approximately \$277,145; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow Child Advocacy Center to provide child advocacy services; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, the Finance Committee has approved the Child Advocacy Center Department's request to apply for the VOCA (Victims of Child Abuse) grant and the committee recommends that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 23rd day of June, 2020, approves the acceptance of the VOCA (Victims of Child Abuse) grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority. The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.


