WHEREAS, the Department of the Sheriff's Office wishes to apply for and accept an a grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation for the Sustained Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) program in the amount of approximately 38,161.77; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow the Sheriff's Office to provide High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) on specific times and dates of the year; and

WHEREAS, as documented by the approval of this resolution, the Jail Committee and the Finance Committee have approved the the Sheriff's Office Department's request to apply for the Sustained Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant and the committees recommend that the County Board approve the acceptance of this grant, if awarded by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sangamon County Board, in session this 7th day of March, 2023, approves the acceptance of the Sustained Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant, which is detailed above, if the grant is awarded to the County by the Illinois Department of Transportation. The County Administrator is authorized to sign required grant documents to execute the agreement for this grant.
