

RESOLUTION NO. 8-1

WHEREAS, Sangamon County would like to implement a Video Arraignment System in the Courts and Detention Center starting with a base system that can be expanded in the future;

WHEREAS, the base system will include two courtrooms, 5C and 7C, as well as two video locations in the Detention Center;

WHEREAS, the base Video Arraignment System will improve the efficiency of the Court's and Sheriff's Office's by reducing the need to transport defendants to the Courtroom.

WHEREAS, a request for proposal for the Video Arraignment System has been issued and a vendor has been selected.


WHEREAS, the selected vendor is Thompson Electronics Company from Peoria Illinois.

WHEREAS, the cost for the Video Arraignment System including three years of maintenance, cabling, and other miscellaneous expenses is \$103,610.

WHEREAS, grant funds from the US Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services technology grant (COPS) have been approved to be used to fund this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois in session this 13th day of March, 2012, that the base Video Arraignment System be approved.
