This grant supports local health departments to insure basic levels of protection are provided for infectious disease, food production, safety of potable water, and private sewage disposal in the amount of \$232,837.00. The grant this year also includes monies for lead poisoning prevention (\$101,000.00), vector surveillance and prevention for mosquito borne diseases (\$35,858.00) and Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis services for clients at risk for HIV (\$35,000.00).

We will be hiring 1 new nurse to support the lead program at a cost of approximately \$68,973 for salaries/fringes. The grant monies for Sangamon and Menard combined were increased to \$111,400 due to changes to the Lead Poisoning Prevention Act that increased caseloads.
