

RESOLUTION # 9-1

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Illinois provides that units of local government may associate among themselves to obtain or share services and to exercise, combine, or transfer any power or function, in any manner not prohibited by law or by ordinance, Ill. Const., Art. VII, § 10 (1970); and,

WHEREAS, Illinois statutes provide that public agencies may share powers through intergovernmental agreement pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*); and,

WHEREAS, Sangamon County has prepared plans and specifications for the Helping Hands Shelter as well as improvements to the entrance and improvements to Shale Street; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield has awarded a contract for their FY2024 Bituminous Road Improvements project; and,

WHEREAS, Sangamon County is a unit of local government; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is a unit of local government; and,

WHEREAS, the City and County desire to complete the construction necessary reconstruction of Shale Street to benefit the proposed Helping Hands Shelter through the use of the City of Springfield FY2024 Bituminous Road Improvements contract; and

WHEREAS, and *Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement* has been prepared; and,

WHEREAS, said Agreement would enable the construction of Shale Street.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Sangamon County, at its **Regular Reconvened Adjourned June Session**, assembled this 8th day of August, A.D., 2023, that the *Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement* is approved; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the County Board of Sangamon County is hereby authorized and directed to sign said Agreement on behalf of Sangamon County.

A G R E E M E N T

This Agreement is made and entered into between the City of Springfield, an Illinois municipal corporation, (hereinafter called the "CITY") and Sangamon County, an Illinois municipal corporation, (hereinafter called "COUNTY")

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Shale Street is owned by and under the jurisdiction of the CITY; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is desirous to have Shale Street milled, widened and resurfaced in the calendar year 2023 to accommodate the future use of the Helping Hands Shelter; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, because of time constraints and the need to be fiscally prudent, is unable to bring about this action without the help of the City; and

WHEREAS, the project is similar to projects that the CITY completes in the annual Bituminous Overlay Program; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY will pay the CITY Contractor for the repair work for Shale Street; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has prepared the engineering necessary for the repairs to Shale Street and the CITY will provide the construction inspection for the Shale Street repairs at no cost to the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, under Article 7, Section 10(A) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, the CITY and the COUNTY may contract with each other to obtain services; and

WHEREAS, under Article 7, Section 10(A) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, the CITY and the COUNTY may use their revenues and other resources to pay costs related to intergovernmental activities; and

WHEREAS, under Article 7 Section 1(C) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, the CITY and the COUNTY may use its technical and financial resources to assist intergovernmental activities.

WHEREAS, Sections 3 and 3.5 (5 ILCS 220/3 and 220/3.5) of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act allow for agreements between public agencies to perform any governmental services or activity that they are authorized to conduct.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. CITY agrees to coordinate the repair and resurfacing of Shale Street from Ash Street to the entrance to the future Helping Hands Shelter by utilizing approved plans and specifications, received unit bid prices, awarded contract, and furnishing inspection during resurfacing and overseeing that said roadway is resurfaced in accordance with the plans, specifications and contracts for resurfacing.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, CITY and COUNTY hereto have caused this AGREEMENT to be made effective and executed by their respective duly authorized officials.
