

RESOLUTION **9-1**  
Section 12-00HSR-00-EG

**WHEREAS**, the STATE has entered into agreements for the design and construction of infrastructure and station improvements, and grade crossing improvements along the High Speed Rail Route from Union Station in Chicago, Illinois to St. Louis Gateway Station in St. Louis, Missouri ("HSR Route") along the Union Pacific Railroad right of way (collectively, the "Project"); and,

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of public safety and convenience, the STATE shall pursue the design and engineering work for the local roads affected by the Project's improvements to the HSR Route; and,

**WHEREAS**, the STATE seeks Sangamon County (COUNTY) review, comment and approval of Preliminary Plans, Intersection Design Studies, Final Plans, and Type, Size & Location ("TS&Ls"); and,

**WHEREAS**, STATE agrees to fund the COUNTY expedited review of the Preliminary Plans, Intersection Design Studies, Final Plans and TS&Ls with an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00; and,

**WHEREAS**, the engineering will be funded with 100% State or Federal funds; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for Sangamon County to execute a "High Speed Rail Local Roads Engineering Agreement" with the State of Illinois for projects with state or federal funds.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County at its **Regular Reconvened Adjourned September Session**, assembled this 9<sup>th</sup> day of October, A.D., 2012, that the "High Speed Rail Local Roads Engineering Agreement" between Sangamon County and the State of Illinois, be approved; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the County Board of Sangamon County that the Chairman of the County Board is hereby authorized and directed to sign said Agreement on behalf of Sangamon County.
