

**RESOLUTION 9-1**  
**ESTABLISHING**  
**OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL EXPLORATORY COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the County of Sangamon has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, concerned citizens and taxpayers in Sangamon County have the right to seek information about their units of government and elected officials and to report or otherwise call attention to any actual or perceived misconduct on the part of elected and/or appointed officials and employees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield, a municipal corporation located within Sangamon County, Illinois, is establishing an Office of Inspector General to investigate allegations of official misconduct, waste, fraud, and abuse; and

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is investigating options for forming and funding said Office of Inspector General; and

WHEREAS, a similar program could be beneficial to the government of Sangamon County; and

WHEREAS, there exists a history of cooperation between the City of Springfield and Sangamon County to work together on programs of mutual concern and benefit, often at great savings to the taxpayers.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the Chairman of the County Board is hereby directed to appoint two members of the Republican caucus and the Democratic Floor Leader is directed to appoint one member of the Democratic caucus to serve as the Office of Inspector General Exploratory Committee.

Section 2. Said three member committee shall initiate discussions and negotiate with the City of Springfield concerning the possibility of entering into an intergovernmental agreement to bring the services of the city's Office of Inspector General to county government.

Section 3. The committee's mandate shall include formulating alternatives to a cooperative arrangement with the City of Springfield in the event an agreement with the City of Springfield cannot be reached.

Section 4. The committee shall render its recommendation(s) to the full County Board within one year of the date of this resolution.
