# Andy Goleman MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING SANGAMON COUNTY AUDITOR

BETWEEN

#### CITY OF SPRINGFIELD

#### **AND**

#### SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS

This Agreement is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of May, 2020, by and between the City of Springfield, Police Dept. hereinafter referred to as "City," and the County of Sangamon, Sheriff's Office hereinafter referred to as "County," both of Sangamon County, Illinois, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the City and the County find that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the parties for the services or functions under this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the 2020 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Award Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to provide the County Thirty-Five percent (35%) of the total amount of funds received from the 2020 JAG award;

NOW THEREFORE, the City and County agree as follows:

#### Section 1

The City of Springfield will serve as the grant's applicant/fiscal agent for the funds. The City agrees to pay to the County a total of 35% of JAG Award funds received.

#### Section 2

The County agrees to use the JAG funds for the purpose Law Enforcement as outlined in the Justice Assistance Grant application information.

### Section 3

Each party to this Agreement shall be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this Agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

## Section 4

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations, express or implied, other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.

## Section 6
