Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Chatham Area Public Library District of Sangamon County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to 0.095600% above the limiting rate for the purpose of the establishment, maintenance, and support of the public library for levy year 2023 and be equal to 0.359214% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year 2025? - (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$1,278,690.00 and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$1,778,945.00.
- (2) For the 2025 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000.00 is estimated to be \$33.67.
- (3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2025 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).

- (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$2,479,511 and the approximate amount extendable if the proposition is approved is \$4,367,722.
- (2) For the 2025 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single-family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000.00 is estimated to be \$129.
- (3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2025 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for Cooper Township, Sangamon County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to .02 percent above the limiting rate for levy year 2023 and be equal to .1527 percent of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year 2025? - (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$42,130.00 and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$50,222.00.
- (2) For the 2025 levy year, the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing an owner-occupied single-family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000.00 is estimated to be \$9.14.
- (3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2025 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).
