  - b. **Animal Control:**  
John reported due to space constraints and the high census number of dogs, some hard decisions are going to need to be made, as far as euthanasia. Last quarter, live release rate was over 95%, which is way above the national average. This shows the staff is making great efforts in getting animals adopted or transferred to rescue groups. John continued that the backyard breeders are a big issue in Sangamon County and throughout the nation.
  - c. **Environmental Health Strategy:**  
John stated he is restructuring the Environmental Health Division. There will be new incoming supervision and reorganized leadership. This will save on the labor side of the cost of that division.
  - d. **Clinic**  
John announced a Nurse Practitioner will hopefully be starting at SCDPH soon. Will be reaching out to her with an offer. This will be someone that will be employed by SCDPH, not SIU.
