RESOLUTION 6-1

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board Chairman, through a Proclamation of Sangamon County Disaster (hereinafter the “Proclamation”) executed by him and which was effective and filed with the Sangamon County Clerk on March 16, 2020, proclaimed that a disaster existed in Sangamon County as a result of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the Members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session the 23rd day of March, 2020, adopted a resolution providing that the March 16, 2020, Proclamation of Sangamon County Disaster would be continued until the Board, via a duly enacted resolution, declared that the need to address the disaster as allowed by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act had ended; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned acts of the Board Chairman and the Board were taken pursuant to Section 11(a) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11(a), and Section 2.56.080 of the Sangamon County Code; and

WHEREAS, the effects of the COVID-19 virus upon persons in Sangamon County have significantly lessened, and it is no longer necessary for Sangamon County to address the COVID-19 disaster as allowed by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Members of the Board of Sangamon County, Illinois, in session this 8th day of March, 2022, that the COVID-19 disaster which is the subject of the March 16, 2020, Proclamation of

Sangamon County Disaster as continued by the Board on March 23, 2020, has ended, and, therefore, there is no longer a need to address the disaster as allowed by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act. This Resolution shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.


